AGREEMENT CLAUSE

Furthermore, the undersigned does hereby agree to save and hold the following entities, their agents, employees and all other exhibitors harmless from any and all claims, damages or expenses arising out of the undersigned's activities occurring at CHF M: Town of Hillsdale, Town of Copake, and the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation.

This RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT includes claims by third parties and including reasonable attorney fees incurred by the Town of Hillsdale, its agents, employees and other exhibitors in defense of such claims; the Town of Copake, its agents, employees and other exhibitors in defense of such claims; and the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation, its agents, employees and other exhibitors in defense of such claims.

This RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT may not be changed orally.
